Years 3 to 6: Measurement

What does your school day look like?

Students start by completing a log of their usual daily events. They can fill in the start of school, school subjects, lunch, recess, and home time.

7am	07:00	Get ready for School
8am	08:00	Travel to school
9am	09:00	Start school / Maths
10am	10:00	English
11am	11:00	Recess / Music

Pose questions



- How long before going to bed do you eat dinner?
- How many more hours do you sleep than go to school?
- Which activity takes most of your time?

Students build their own 24-hour activity clock



Converting Time

The bus timetable says it leaves at 16:00. What is that in 12-hour time?



Students research real examples of time such as timetables for local buses, trains, trams, or even flights.
